



There are two methods of assembly for the provided clips. This will depend if you are attaching to a ceiling grid system or direct fixing to a ceiling or wall.








Ceiling grid


Ceiling grid method:

- For ceiling grid use, assemble track clip and panel clip using one e-clip.
- Gently press the sides of the track clip inwards, whilst pushing the clip up against the ceiling grid, until it clicks into position.
- Rotate the panel clip to suit direction of EchoPanel[®].
- Use the provided diagram to space the clips on a standard ceiling grid.















Step 2

 When all the clips are fixed, you will have a grid of clips ready to install the blades.




Step 3

• Slot top and bottom blades together forming a square grid.




- Push EchoPanel® Element into the clips, making sure all 16 clips are holding the structure.
- The clips supplied are appropriate for the installation of one EchoPanel® Element kit.




EchoPanel® Element shown completed on a standard ceiling



Direct fix method:

- For direct fix to a ceiling or wall, select only the panel clip and washer.
- Using the clips spacing diagram from the grid install, mark out the placement of the clips.
- Prepare the wall or ceiling surface, installing appropriate wall plugs if needed.
- Use a screwdriver to fix the panel clip directly to the surface, using the washer provided.
- Rotate the panel clip to suit direction of EchoPanel®.








 Reflected ceiling elevation placement and spacing of ceiling clips.








Step 2

- Undo the top section of the ceiling fixture and screw fix it to the ceiling.
- Then re-assemble the fixture.



- Feed the cable through the ceiling fixture, by undoing and pushing the bottom part of the fixture.
- Adjust the length of the cable, tighten the fixture, then trim excess cable.



Step 4

- When all the fixtures have been installed, you will have a grid of cables and clips ready to install EchoPanel® Element.
- Ensure all the cables have been adjusted to the desired length.



- Assemble EchoPanel® Element as per Installation guide at the beginning of this document.
- Push EchoPanel® Element into the clips, making sure all 16 clips are holding the structure.
